GENERAL INFORMATION ON SELECTION PROCEDURE

- 1. Engagement on the above-mentioned positions will be purely on a temporary basis, initially for one year from the date of engagement and likely to be extended for further periods, depending upon the requirement and performance appraisal.
- 2. The application form can be downloaded from the Institute's website www.wii.gov.in/
- 3. Mere fulfilment of the minimum advertised qualifications and experience requirement DOES NOT automatically entitle an applicant to be called for written test.
- 4. All applications should be accompanied with a Demand Draft of Rs. 1000 (Rupees one thousand only) drawn in favour of The Director, Wildlife Institute of India, Dehra Dun payable at Dehra Dun. Applicants belonging to SC/ ST/ OBC/ and Physically handicapped categories are exempted from this.
- 5. All eligible and shortlisted candidates will be asked to appear for a written test to be conducted separately for both positions at the Institutes' campus at Chandrabani, Dehra Dun on Monday, October 30, 2017 between 9:30 hours and 13:00 hours. Based on the written test, top 5 candidates in the merit list for each position separately will be called for personal interview. The questions for written test will be of objective type and of the standard of Master's Degree in Wildlife Sciences (www.wii.gov.in/) and the duration of the test will be one hour.
- 6. The decision of the Institute in all matters relating to eligibility, acceptance or rejection of application, mode of selection will be final and binding on the candidates and no enquiry or correspondence will be entertained from any individual or his/her agency. The selected candidates will be governed by the Institute's rules, amended from time to time.
- 7. Candidate(s) should bring in duly filled-in application with attested true copies of testimonials of educational qualifications, experience, extra-curricular activities, date of birth etc., along with copies of mark sheets of all examinations and submit at the registration desk in the Institute's auditorium at 0930 hours on 30th October 2017. All original documents should also be produced at the time of personal interview on 30th October 2017 scheduled between 1500 hours to 1700 hours. Applications without enclosures and/or incomplete in any respect shall be rejected.
- 8. The Institute will not provide accommodation for candidates appearing for the written test and personal interview.
- 9. No TA/DA will be paid for attending the interview.
- 10. Canvassing in any form is liable to rejection of the candidature.
