2. Under Project XIII River Terrapin, the Essential Qualification for ‘Project Assistant’ position is **BSc degree** with minimum 55% marks in the subjects mentioned.

3. Selection Criteria

The criteria for shortlisting qualifying candidates will be based on an online written test in any one of the 14 centres (Thiruvananthapuram, Chennai, Hyderabad, Bengaluru, Bhopal, Mumbai, Delhi, Lucknow, Dehra Dun, Ranchi, Kolkata, Guwahati, Aizawl and Jammu) on **28 August, 2022 (Sunday) at 1000 hrs**. The allocation of test centres would be decided by the institute on the basis of number of candidates registered for a particular centre and the candidate would be accordingly informed.

All applicants are requested to mention their choice of test centre in their application.

The online test will be for 2 hours duration for 30 marks. The question paper would have the following sections:

Section 1: 20 Multiple Choice Objective questions (1 mark each)

Section 2: An Essay (200 words) on environment, forest, wildlife species or conservation issues (10 marks)

The top 20% meritorious candidates or 5 per position advertised whichever is smaller will be short-listed for the personal / online interview to be held at the **Wildlife Institute of India, Chandrabani, Dehradun** during the period **5-9 September 2022**.
