On behalf of Director of Wildlife Institute of India, Government of India, sealed bids are invited for condemnation of vehicle (Maruti Gypsy) for scrap purpose only under on “As- is –where- is- basis”.

A. General:

1. Tender Document can be downloaded from the website (www.wii.gov.in).

B. Details of Auction:

1. The above vehicle is located in the premises of NMDC Diamond Mine Township, Majhgawan, Panna, Madhya Pradesh - 488001. Details of contact person for inspection and tender accepting authority are as under:

2. An EMD of Rs. 4,000/- (Rupees Four Thousand only) should be deposited with the tender in the form of an Account Payee Bank Draft/Pay order from any Nationalized bank in favour of **“The Director, Wildlife Institute of India, Dehradun”**

C. General Terms & Conditions:

1. Bidders may inspect the items on the stipulated dates & time.
2. The vehicle is only for scrap purpose. An affidavit in this regard from First class magistrate is required, before giving possession and a letter is to be sent to transport authority for cancellation of registration.
3. The highest bidder will be liable for future legal matters whatsoever, pertaining to the vehicle after taking delivery.
4. The items shall be sold to the highest bidder. The bids are invited for condemnation of vehicle (Maruti Gypsy) as a whole, and no bid would be accepted for any part of the same.
5. The earnest money Deposit (EMD) of successful bidder shall be adjusted from the total payment. The EMD of unsuccessful bidders shall be returned within one month of the auction date, without any interest.
6. The successful bidder has to make full balance payment, after due adjustment of the EMD, in the form of Demand draft in favour of **“The Director, Wildlife Institute of India, Dehradun”** within three days after confirmation, failing which the offer will be cancelled and the EMD shall stand forfeited.
7. No item once disposed to the successful bidder shall be taken back by this Department on any condition whatsoever.

8. The successful bidder will be required to lift all the items from the disposal site within five days after the payment of the balance amount. On failure to do so this office shall have the right to forfeit the entire amount of the bidder and dispose of the item through the alternate bidder. The successful bidder, on their own cost, will also be required to make their own arrangement of transport, labour etc. for lifting the disposed items.
9. Quotation letter in the sealed envelope super subscribed (TENDER FOR CONDEMNATION OF VEHICLE (MARUTI GYPSY)" should be addressed to Registrar, Wildlife Institute of India, Dehradun .
10. Tenders received after the due date and time due to any reason whatsoever shall not be considered.
11. The financial bid should be given in both in figures and words. Any overwriting or erasing in the figures shall not be considered for acceptance of the rates offered by the tenderer.
12. The Wildlife Institute of India reserves the right to accept or reject any/all quotations without assigning any reason whatsoever.
13. Each page of tender document should be signed by the bidder(s).
14. Incomplete and unsigned quotations are liable to be rejected.
15. Bidder must enclose copy of address proof (Voter I-card/Aadhar Card/Driving License etc.) and PAN card along with the bid.
16. An earnest Money Deposit (EMD) of Rs. 4,000/- (Rupees Four thousand only) must accompany the quotation, without which the relevant bid shall be summarily rejected.
17. **Taxes: Taxes** shall also be payable by the bidder on the total quoted price and shall be charged as per rules.
18. Force Majeure
 - A) However, the agency shall not be liable for forfeiture of its performance security, liquidated damages or termination for default, if and to the extent that, it's delay in performance or other failure to perform its obligations under the Contract is the result of an event of Force Majeure.
 - B) For purposes of this Clause, "Force Majeure" means an event beyond the control of the agency and not involving the agencies fault or negligence and not foreseeable. Such

events may include, but are not limited to, acts of the Institute either in its sovereign or contractual capacity, wars or revolutions, fires, floods, epidemics, quarantine restrictions and freight embargoes.

C) If a Force Majeure situation arises; the agency shall promptly notify the Institute in writing of such conditions and the cause thereof. Unless otherwise directed by the Institute in writing, the agency shall continue to perform its obligations under the Contract as far as is reasonably practical, and shall seek all reasonable alternative means for performance not prevented by the Force Majeure event.

19. Resolution of Disputes: All disagreements, disputes, difference that may arise between the Wildlife Institute of India and the bidder which cannot be resolved through mutual negotiations shall be referred to an Arbitrator appointed in accordance with the provisions of relevant Indian or International Law as the case may be. The venue of the proceedings and arbitration shall be Dehradun, Uttarakhand, India.

20. Jurisdiction: The obligations and liabilities arising out of this contract shall be construed in accordance with the laws of Union of India. The Court in Dehradun, Uttarakhand, India shall have the exclusive jurisdiction to try all or any of the dispute.
