DETAILED REPORT

The Wildlife Institute of India (WII), Dehradun under the project "Biodiversity Conservation and Ganga Rejuvenation" conducted a consultation workshop on "Waste Management for Ganga Biodiversity Conservation" at Chila, Garhwal Mandal Vikas Nigam Guest House, Rishikesh, on 28th December 2019. The workshop was attended by 34 participants. The objective of the workshop was to sensitize the stakeholders particularly related to tourism such as hoteliers, tour operators, tourist guides and raft owners towards cleanliness and conservation of Ganga River and to facilitate their long-term association with the project. The workshop started with a welcome address by Dr. Sangeeta Angom, and highlighting the issues of waste management and segregation at tourist places. Dr. Niladri Dasgupta, gave a detailed overview of the NMCG-WII project related to its inception, the major objectives, the work that has already started in the other Ganga river states and what initiatives needs to be taken for the biodiversity conservation of the Ganga river. Thereafter, Mr. Shikhar Paliwal gave a talk on waste management issues at Haridwar. The function concluded with a group discussion with the participants.
