With reference to your Office Note cited above the para-wise replies to the RTI application of Shri Jasvir Uttarakhandi are furnished below:

1. Zoos in India are managed as per the provisions of the Wildlife (Protection) Act, 1972 and guided by the National Zoo Policy, 1988. Captive animals can be kept in zoos for exhibition to the public after obtaining prior approval of the Central Zoo Authority as per the provisions of Chapter IV of the Wildlife Protection Act, 1972 & the Recognition of Zoo Rules 2009. For further details you may kindly contact the Central Zoo Authority.
2. As per the National Zoo Policy, 1998, the main objective of keeping captive animals in zoo is for:
 - a. Supporting the conservation of endangered species by breeding in ex-situ conditions raising stock for rehabilitating in wild;
 - b. to inspire visitors for empathy towards wildlife, generating understanding and awareness about conservation;
 - c. Opportunity for scientific research;
 - d. to function as rescue centres for orphan animals.

3. As per the Zoo policy individuals are discouraged and not permitted to keep captive animals in their individual possession. Possession of captive animals are governed by the Wildlife Protection Act, 1972. For further details please contact Central Zoo Authority.
