

8. Details of experience of working in Protected Areas Wildlife Research, Conservation and Management including natural world heritage conservation (maximum 2 pages only)

I have been working the field of Protected Areas/Wildlife Research, Conservation and Management including natural world heritage conservation for nearly fourteen years. My recent and current work at the Wildlife Institute of India as a Consultant in a project on the preparation of India's Fifth National Report to the Convention on Biological Diversity (CBD) and updating of the National Biodiversity Action Plan (NBAP) involves extensive review of conservation of biodiversity in India at the levels of policies, plans, programmes and activities including conservation through Protected Areas (PAs), Natural World Heritage Sites (WHS) and other area-based conservation measures as well as wildlife research and management. Through this work, an important understanding was gained of the CBD's Programme of Work on Protected Areas (PoWPA) and its implementation globally and in India and its role in offering an effective framework in supporting the CBD and the World Heritage Convention (Convention Concerning the Protection of the World Cultural and Natural Heritage). A key part of the work involved developing National Biodiversity Targets and biodiversity indicators and monitoring framework. As area-based conservation measures including PAs. World Heritage Sites and Biodiversity Heritage Sites are a crucial element of national biodiversity conservation strategy, indicators were developed to measure biodiversity status and monitor trends for reporting and reviewing using systematic and feasible methods.

Under the project, I also contributed in organizing and conducting several national and regional consultations and workshops for involvement of various stakeholders in the process of preparation of the National Report to the CBD and updating of NBAP.

Prior to my current assignment, I have worked as a Professional Associate and Consultant at The Biodiversity Consultancy. Cambridge for/in collaboration with international organisations such as Fauna and Flora International, BirdLife International, the International Union for Conservation of Nature (IUCN) and the International Finance Corporation (IFC/The World Bank) as well as major global corporations in infrastructure development and industrial sectors. I gained valuable experience in assessing and reviewing impacts and their management particularly related to critical habitats for wildlife, PAs. World Heritage sites and areas of high biodiversity value as well as monitoring and evaluation for biodiversity under international and national requirements for biodiversity and sustainable development as per principles and standards such as those of the Convention on Biological Diversity (CBD), the World Heritage Convention, and the International Finance Corporation (IFC) Performance Standards for Biodiversity.

In 2012-2013, I carried out an assessment of biodiversity for the Humayun's Tomb World Heritage Site Sunder Nursery Hazrat Nizamuddin Basti project of the Aga Khan Foundation and the Aga Khan Trust for Culture, New Delhi as part of a study by Nature Science Initiative. The project combines conservation of cultural heritage with nature and environment conservation and socio-economic development while working with local communities and stakeholders. This study involved monitoring and management of

biodiversity across seasons in a year in areas under restoration of natural and cultural heritage as well as engagement with the local communities living around the site and the public.

I gained valuable experience at the IUCN Species Programme, Cambridge whilst working as a volunteer particularly in species' threat status criteria and assessment and in the Species Information Service (SIS) information and management system for global threat status assessments and contributed to review of Global Assessments for the Indo-Burma region for freshwater biodiversity.

I carried out extensive research leading to a Ph.D. degree, wherein I analysed the responses of biodiversity across low to high yielding land-use intensities through an empirical study of the relationship between agricultural yields and population densities of wildlife in the upper Gangetic plain. My research involved data collection and analyses of biodiversity and also socio-economic data that involved interview-based surveys of farmers, forest field staff and management and relevant stakeholders. Results from the study (published in the journal *Science* - please see section "9. Any other relevant information - Publications") underlined the need to develop strategies for increasing agricultural production while minimizing its impacts and suggest targeting conservation efforts in Protected Areas and reserves as well as in conserving species of conservation concern in areas under human land use and the wider landscape.

During my earlier work at the Wildlife Institute of India (WII) as a junior research fellow and as a project person at the EIA cell, I conducted research work and surveys for ecological assessment of impacts of linear infrastructure and extractive industry on PAs and wildlife. I contributed in the formulation of the UN Foudation (UNF) – UNESCO project "Development of World Heritage Biodiversity Programme for India (WIIBPI 2002-2005) Phase I" at WII.

More recently, I have contributed to the WII - UNESCO project "Climate Change Adaptation Workbook - Responding to Climate Change: A Guide for Managers of Natural World Heritage Sites 2012-2013".

I have also gained valuable experience in teaching, training and conservation awareness and outreach programmes for practitioners, PA managers, forest department frontline staff, local government personnel, corporate personnel, members of local communities and the public, and University students (Please see section "9. Any other relevant information" for details).






