The project aims to assess the wildlife values and the land tenure of Changthang and Karakoram Wildlife Sanctuaries through field investigations and stakeholder consultations in order to plan rationalization of boundaries for these protected areas.

Note: Only candidates in excellent health condition, physical and mental fitness, and willing to conduct arduous field work in remote, high altitude regions (> 3500m above MSL) of Ladakh under extreme weather conditions need to apply.

4. Application forms needs to be typed according to the prescribed format and must be accompanied by: (a) Scanned copies of educational qualifications, and (b) Scanned copies of experience letter/ certificate/ publications / proof of age, failing which applications will not be considered.
