The Wildlife Institute of India, Dehra Dun invites application for engagement of the following Project Personnel in the Project “**Development of Landscape Management Plan for the SECURE Himalaya Landscapes in Uttarakhand**” purely on contractual basis for a period of 6 months.

The project “*Securing livelihoods, conservation, sustainable use and restoration of high range Himalayan ecosystems*” commonly known as the “**SECURE Himalaya Project**” proposes a paradigm shift from the current conservation practices to demonstrate a new approach of landscape-based conservation in select regions of the Indian Himalayan Region (IHR). To achieve the salient project objectives for the two identified SECURE Landscapes in the state of Uttarakhand (*i.e.* the Gangotri-Govind and the Darma-Byans-Chaudans landscape), several different project components were formulated, and were carried out in a largely independent capacity by independent agencies. The project aims to develop a participatory, landscape-level management plan for the SECURE Landscapes of Uttarakhand by consolidating the findings and recommendations of inter-dependent and mutually non-exclusive reports of these agencies

5. The shortlisted candidates will be notified (through email and website notification) for online personal interview by **20th Jan. 2021**. The **online interview** will be held on **25th Jan. 2021 from 1000 hrs onwards**.
6. At the time of verification of original documents, if it is found that an attempt has been made by the applicant to wilfully conceal, misrepresent or canvass the facts, his/her candidature will not be considered.
7. The positions advertised are purely temporary/ contractual for the project period only and will stand abolished after completion of the project.
8. The tenure in the project will be governed by the Institute’s rules and regulations
