

## Declaration of Result of Written Examination to call candidates for appearing in Tier-II (Skill/ Trade) Test (Staff Recruitment Advertisement No. WII/ADM/2025/60)

Wildlife Institute of India (WII), Dehradun conducted written examination for the posts of Lab Attendant and Technician (Audio Visual) on 11.01.2026 at Dehradun, Uttarakhand.

Information regarding the result of written examination to call candidates for Tier-II (Skill/ Trade) Test is as follows: -

- As per Para No. 7 of 'PROCEDURE FOR APPLYING' of the Staff Recruitment Advertisement, minimum qualifying marks in Written Examination are fixed as follows:
  - OBC : 30%
  - SC : 30%
- Based on the performance of candidates in the Written Examination, **15 candidates (out of 42 appeared)** for the post of **Lab Attendant**, in the ratio of **1:5 against the total number of posts**, and **03 candidates (out of 05 appeared)** for the post of **Technician (Audio Visual)** have **provisionally qualified for appearing in Tier-II (Skill/Trade) Test**.
