The matter has been examined and following comments are offered:-

As per the clarifications issued vide para (h) of Annexure to Govt. of India, Ministry of Finance, Department of Expenditure, New Delhi letter No. F.14(10)E-Coord/88 dated 4.10.1988, contract employees like resident doctors, consolidated salary workers in Registrar General of India etc. can be considered for the benefit of Ad-hoc bonus at par with casual labours provided a provision to this effect exists in the agreement of these contract employees. Research fellows, however, are not eligible. It is relevant to mention that as per the conditions of payment of bonus to casual labourers, only those are to be considered who have worked for at least 240 days each year for at least last three years (having six days a week) or 206 days each year for last three years (for five days a week) and amount is to be calculated on the maximum ceiling of Rs. 1200/- as per the conditions of Govt. of India, Ministry of Finance and Company Affairs, New Delhi letter no. 14(6)-E-Coord-1/2003 dated 29.9.2003.

If the contract employees working in WII (other than Research Fellows) are to be considered at par with those for which the clarification has been provided vide Govt. of India letter dated 04.10.1988 ibid, an amount of Rs.1184/-(Rs.1200/- \times 30 ÷ 30.4) can be paid to each eligible contract employee provided a suitable mention in this regard is framed in the contract agreement.

Payment of Adhoc-bonus to personnel engaged on contractual

basis.

Sir,

With due respect, We, the following personnel engaged on contractual basis, submit that as per orders on payment of adhoc-bonus, personnel engaged on contractual basis are also eligible for grant of bonus on pro-rata basis as we are working continuously from 2nd January to 31st December with a break in service for one day on 1st January every year.

This issue was also raised during the previous years, but it was not commented as per the rules by the then Finance Officer and this remained unsolved till now. We are, therefore, once again requesting you to kindly accord necessary permission for grant of adhoc-bonus to the personnel engaged on contractual basis as admissible to the personnel working on daily wages/temporary service with the Government Departments. In fact, the admissibility of adhoc-bonus had to be clearly mentioned in the appointment letters being given to the engagees but the same aspect has not determined at the time of issue of the same.

We are hopeful that you would be kind enough to consider our request for grant of adhoc- bonus on pro-rata basis as admissible under rules for which act of generosity, we shall be most grateful.

Sub: Review of Performance Report of Contractual Engagees in WII and fresh contract offer for the year 2004.

The Meeting of the Internal Governance Committee met on 12.12.2003 to Review of Contractual Appointment in WII and for fresh contractual appointment under various project and under grant in aid of the Institute.

The IGC considered the performance report of the contractual engagees engaged in the Institute in its various projects and to consider the continuation and fresh contractual engagement of the staff on contract basis for the year 2004. Seed on the recommendations of the various controlling officers of the contract employees, a summary list of 39 contractual staff was prepared and placed before the IGC. After discussion the IGC had agreed for fresh contractual appointment in WII. The following was further decided in the IGC Meeting:

- It was also decided that one day break on 1.1.2004 should be given to all employees to be engaged on contract basis.
- (2) In case of Shri Vinay Kumar Sharma, Administrative Assistant who was appointed under Terai Arc Project was recommended for placement with Dr. Y.V. Jhala, HoD, AECB as the officer has not been provided the Secretarial Assistance.
- (3) In case of Shri Satendra Kumar, Driver who was appointed under Terai Arc Project was recommended for further engagement on contract basis upto 31.12.2004 as the Vehicle purchased under Terai Arc Project would be available and the services of the driver is necessary. It was also decided to book his salary under Research Project head of the grant in aid.
- (4) Shri V. Rajkumar, Adminstrative Assistant cum Stenographer who has been appointed under US-FWS Project and at present is placed with HoD, PMCR was recommended for contractual engagement. The IGC decided that the consolidated emoluments should be paid by calculating the consolidated emoluments in the pay scale of Rs.5000-8000/-.
- (5) In case of Shri Mohan Singh, Driver engaged under the WII Research Project "Status and Biology of Leopard in Pauri Garhwal, the IGC decided to give a fresh contractual offer from the funds of EIA Cell from where his salary was booked earlier and he will be posted in WII and may be used in

pool. The IGC decided that Dr. S.P. Goyal, PI of the Project may 1 requested to engaged a driver in the field station for the above mentioned research project.

- (6) In case of Shri S.B.S. Sajwan, Accountant under USFS Project, the IGC decided to appoint him for three months i.e. upto March, 2004 only due to winding up of the Project.

Medical Facilities: The IGC decided that in place of Medical Insurance Policy of Rs.1.50 lakhs to the contractual engagees, it was decided to provide a medical allowance to the contractual employees (self only) of Rs.200/- per month for meeting the cost of consultation from WII approved medical practioners and cost of medicines subject to an overall ceiling of Rs.5,000/- in a year and on submission of duly certified bills. This medical provision will not be applicable to those contractual employees availing medical facilities from other sources.

(10) Bonus: The IGC considered the recommendations given by the Internal Audit Officer for providing Bonus to Contractual employees. After discussion it was agreed by the IGC to include this item in the next year contract agreement by putting a suitable clause.

The IGC had also decided that before putting the clause No. (9) and (10) above i.e. medical and bonus to contractual employees, the opinion of the legal retainer should be obtained.

The undersigned had gone to the Legal Retainer today (22.12.2003) in connection with his opinion on the matter of CDL as per decision of the High Court, Uttaranchal for allowing minimum pay scale of the post. After that the undersigned had a discussion with him for medical and bonus to the contractual engagees to be engaged for the next year (2004). It was opined by him that there was no legal complications by allowing medical facility as proposed in item No. 9 above in place of existing medical insurance policy and by paying them bonus as per GOI norms.



Sub: Review of Performance Report of Contractual Engagees in WII and fresh contract offer for the year 2005 - Reg.

The Institute has engaged contractual staff at various levels to carry out the activities of various projects and under grant in aid of the Institute work. The list of the contractual staff engaged during the year 2004 is placed at page 186-183/c for perusal.

The performance report in respect of all contractual staff (39 Nos.) was requested from their controlling officers depending upon the further requirement during the year 2005. The performance reports have been received and are placed at page 57-1/c in the linked file for perusal please.

The following is submitted for fresh engagements of contractual staff during the year 2005:

- (1) Every year one day break on 1st January is given. This year 1st and 2nd January, 200° are Gazetted holidays (Saturday & Sunday) and hence, break day will be considered on 3rd January, 2004. Fresh contractual engagements will be effective from 4.1 2005:
 - (2) The detailed terms and conditions duly vetted by Legal Retainer were again sent to him for re-examination in the light of recent judicial pronouncements on contract labour. The terms and conditions have been re-examined and vetted by the Legal Retainer and are placed at page 231-226/c for perusal. His work output was always delayed and not upto the standard of the Institute. His competency in English language and computer skills is not to the desized level and has always led to wastage of

time, paper and energy in getting the work completed. Reports of his poor conduct with the office staff and his inability to maintain working relationship with them were received.

It is also pointed out that during field Orientation cum Technique Tour of Certificate Course to Rajaji National Park during November, 2001 he fought with one another staff (Driver) and created problem there. On the report of the Tour Incharge, Certificate Course he was issued an Office Memorandum. On his written apology (vide pp 59/c of the linked file), he was given a warning not to repeat such mistake (vide pp 58/c).

Recently, again an incident has come to notice that Shri Govind Singh and Shri Devendra Prasad Kothari, Attendant had hot exchange of works abusing each other in the Academic Cell. A detailed report on this issue has been submitted in a separately file for disciplinary action.

In view of not getting his satisfactory performance in the Academic Cell it is proposed that the case of Shri Govind Singh, Secretarial Assistant for fresh contractual engagement may not be considered.

INFORMATION PROVIDED Vide your letter under Reference and reply my advice UND pinion has been sought regarding payment of Gratuity to the contractual employees engaged by the Institute from time to time.

In this regard I write to draw your attention that the Terms and Conditions of Contractual Engagement do not specify regarding payment of Gratuity to the contractual engagee.

Nevertheless Gratuity will definitely be payable even to the Contract employees either as per the Rules applicable upon the Institute providing for payment of Gratuity or if no such Rules are in existence or in vogue then definitely as per and under the provisions of the Payment of Gratuity Act, 1972.

In this connection I draw your attention to the definition of the term 'employee' as given under Section 2(e) of the Payment of Gratuity Act, 1972 which means "any person [other than an apprentice] who is employed for wages, whether the terms of such employment are express or implied, in any kind of work, manual or otherwise, in or in connection with the work of a factory, mine, oil field, plantation, port, railway company, shop or other establishment to which this Act applies, but does not include any such person who holds a post under the Central Government or a State Government and is governed by any other Act or by any Rules providing for the payment of Gratuity.

Although the contract employees may not be holding any post under the Central Government which working under the Institute but definitely such - contract employees will not get excluded from the definition of the term 'employee' as stated above, as the only categories excluded there from are either the 'apprentices' and or the 'persons who hold a post under the Central or a State Government and is governed by any other Act or by any Rules providing for the payment of Gratuity'.

Therefore the contract employee who has or puts in minimum five [05] years of service will be entitled to receive Gratuity which will be calculated on the basis of last drawn basic wage plus D.A multiplied by the number of years of service multiplied by 15 and the sum divided by 26 [by virtue of Section 4 of the

Payment of Gratuity Act, 1972]. Giving of 1 or 2 days break in between will not constitute a break in service for the purpose of computation, calculation and payment of Gratuity.

Hence in my considered legal opinion the contract employee - person under question and reference - Mr. K.S. Thapa, after putting in much more than the minimum qualifying period of service of 05 years, will definitely be entitled to receive Gratuity, based on the above stated computation. No exemption has been INFORMATION PROVIDED made or even exists for contract employees.

The pay & allowances given to contractual staff was same as was given to regular employee including payment of Bonus and Medial reimbursement. The monthly Gross payment made to contractual staff range between Rs. 7,722/- to 23,266/-. In addition to salary Will is also paying 10% of ay +Grade Pay as Will share of EPF contribution. The Will share of EPF contribution per year works out to Rs. 3.00 lakh. Reasons for payment of pay & allowance at par with the regular staff may be explained. Thus, employing of 48 contractual staff 41 in excess of sanctioned posts without taking the approval of MoEF is irregular. Ex-post facto approval of MoEF in this regard may be obtained to regularize their employment and compliance shown to next audit.


