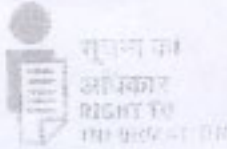

3 (a). List of the staff/officials from MP Forest Department trained in Game Guard Trg. School, Bandhavgarh by WII from February 18-23, 2008


Response: WII's role was to impart training and the details of participations could be obtained from the Field Director, Bandhavgarh Tiger Reserve.
