

Sir,

You are kindly aware that the Wildlife Institute of India has initiated the study on assessment of impacts on wildlife due to helicopter services in Kedarnath Valley in autumn 2015 and this would continue until summer 2016. Based on our initial field observations and perusal of regulatory norms laid by DGCA, we propose the following interim measures based on 'precautionary principle' to reduce impacts on wildlife of Kedarnath WS due to helicopter services in Kedarnath Valley:

1. According to the Noise Pollution (Regulation and Control) rules, 2000 (Annexure-I), the ambient air quality standard for noise for 'Silence Zone' is 50dB. In pursuance of Rule 3(2) of the above Rules, the Government of Goa has included Wildlife Sanctuaries and Reserved Forests under the 'Silence Zone' category (Annexure-II). Our measurements (n=1,521) of noise levels due to helicopter flights that were recorded at six locations along the flight paths during autumn 2015 ranged from 46 dB to 89 dB with a mean of 70 dB (± 6.5 SD), well above the 50 dB upper noise limit prescribed for 'Silence Zone'. Lowest noise levels were observed at Soneprayag where the helicopters tend to fly highest, due to a bend in the Valley. This demonstrates a correlation between helicopter flying height and noise level. It is important that noise levels due to helicopter flights are kept within the noise limit of 50dB for 'Silence Zone'. The Government of Uttarakhand may also consider issuing a notification in this respect as has been done by the Government of Goa (Annexure-II).

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- 2. As per the norms laid by DGCA (Annexure-III), the flights should be operated above 600m (2000') from the ground. Our altitude records of helicopter flights (n=7) made during autumn 2015 revealed that with the exception of one, all helicopter flights have flown less than 600m above ground. The compliance of the above mentioned regulations needs to be strictly adhered so to reduce /minimise disturbances to wildlife due to noise besides having flying safety consideration.
- 3. The State Forest Department or any other agency could monitor the helicopter operator's compliance with regulatory norms laid by DGCA by regular checking of aviation records submitted by the different operators. Monitoring the helicopter altitude and position could be done using equipment such as Laser Distometer, Lidar Gun and setting up of Automatic Dependent Surveillance unit.

We shall be able to submit our final report after completion of field work ending June 2016 during which additional observations on flight operations will be made.

NOTIFICATION

In pursuance of Rule 3 (2) of the Noise Pollution (Regulation and Control) Rules, 2000 (said rules), Government of Goa, hereby notifies the categorization of areas in the State of Goa into Industrial, Commercial and Residential or Silence Areas/Zones, for the purpose of implementation of Noise standards for different areas.

Area Code	Category of Area / Zone
A	All areas, which are included within the industrial estates, mining areas, barge loading facilities and related activity, jetties along the riverfront and all other Industries / Industrial Areas not falling within the above specific areas and zoned as Industrial as per the Regional Plan, 2001 notified by Town and Country Planning Department, Government of Goa, shall be categorized a Industrial Area. For the purpose of designating a specific area to be an Industrial zone the Department of Science, Technology & Environment, in consultation with Directorate of Industries, Trade & Commerce, Department of Tourism and Go State Pollution Control Board shall within six months from the date of thi Notification identify the areas falling within and designate on a map Industrial zone having regard to the predominant character of the locality.

B & C Commercial Area and Residential Area :

All areas which are declared as Commercial/Residential (Settlement Zones) as per the Regional Plan, 2001 or the Outline Development Plans for the respective urban areas in the State of Goa, notified by Town and Country Planning Department, Government of Goa, shall be categorized as Commercial / Residential Areas.

For the purpose of designating a specific area to be Commercial/Residential Area/zone, the 'Authority' shall within six months from the date of this Notification survey the area falling within his jurisdiction and designate on a map Commercial/ Residential Area /zones or a mixed category area, having regard to the predominant character of the locality.

For the purpose of identifying a specific area to be Commercial/Residential Zone for the purpose of permissions under Rule 5(1) of the said rules, the 'Authority' shall examine and survey the area concerned and permit the use of Loudspeaker/ Public Address System, on case to case basis, after satisfying himself that the specific area is substantially Commercial or substantially Residential as the case may be. For this purpose the 'Authority' shall accept an application from any 'person' desirous to use Loudspeaker/Public Address System, 03 (three) days prior, to enable the 'Authority' to carryout the site inspection and survey, failing which the 'Authority' shall not accept the application.

D Silence Zone:

All areas comprising not less than 100 meters around hospitals, educational institution, courts, religious places, wildlife sanctuaries, reserve forests, turtle nesting sites, Heritage/Archeological sites of State/National/International importance and all areas which are identified to be falling within the silence zone as identified by Road Transport Authority, Department of Transport, Government of Goa shall be categorized as Silence Zone.

For the purpose of designating a specific area to be Silence zone, the 'Authority' shall within six months from the date of this Notification survey the area falling within his jurisdiction and designate on a map Silence zone having regard to the predominant character of the locality.

The 'Authority' (as notified vide Notification No.7/4/98/STE-DIR/Part-1/922 dated 04/12/2007, Sr. No. 01 to 12) as listed below, shall carry out the survey to designate the specified areas / zones viz. 'B', 'C' and 'D' and maintain the limits of sound for all areas /zones as prescribed in the schedule to said rules.

- (1) The District Collector, Collectorate (North), Panaji-Goa.
- (2) The District Collector, Collectorate (South), Margao-Goa.
- The Additional Collector (I) and Addl. District Magistrate, North Goa, Panaji.
- (4) The Additional Collector (I) and Addl. District Magistrate, South Goa, Margao-Goa.
- (5) The Dy. Collector & Sub-Divisional Magistrate, Tiswadi, Panaji-Goa.
- (6) The Dy. Collector & Sub-Divisional Magistrate, Ponda-Goa.
- The Dy. Collector & Sub-Divisional Magistrate, Bardez, Mapusa-Goa.
- (8) The Dy. Collector & Sub-Divisional Magistrate, Bicholim-Goa.
- (9) The Dy. Collector & Sub-Divisional Magistrate, Pernem-Goa.

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(10) The Dy. Collector & Sub-Divisional Magistrate, Salcete-Goa.

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THE NOISE POLLUTION (REGULATION AND CONTROL) RULES, 2000

MINISTRY OF ENVIRONMENT & FORESTS

NOTIFICATION

[S.O.123(E) Whereas, the increasing ambient noise level in public places from various sources, inter-alia, industrial activity, construction activity. 2[fire crackers, sound producing instruments], generator sets, loud speakers, public address systems, music systems, vehicular horns and other mechanical devices have deleterious effects on human health and the psychological well being of the people; it is considered necessary to regulate and control of noise producing and generating sources with the objective of maintaining the ambient air quality standards in respect of noise;

Whereas, a draft of Noise Pollution (Regulation and Control) Rule. 1999 was published under the notification of the Government of India in the Ministry of Environment and Forests vide number S.O.528 (E), dated the 28th June, 1999 inviting objections and suggestions from all the persons likely to be affected thereby, before the expiry of the period of sixty days from the date on which the copies of the Gazette containing the said notification are made available to the public:

And, whereas, copies of the said Gazette were made available to the public on the 1st day of July, 1999;

And, whereas the objections and suggestions received from the public in respect of the said draft rules have been duly considered by the Central Government:

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by clause (ii) of sub-section (2) of section 3, sub-section (1) and clause (b) of sub-section (2) of section 6 and section 25 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) read with Rule 5 of the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986, the Central Government hereby makes the following rules for the regulation and control of noise producing and generating sources. namely:-


"A", in dB(A) Leq, denotes the frequency weighting in the measurement of noise and corresponds to frequency response characteristics of the human ear.

Leq: It is an energy mean of the noise level over a specific period.

1. The State of Uttarakhand shall takes Immediate steps to submit its purposal for notificati of Eco Sensitive Zone Covering Kedarnath Wild life Sanctuary as Well as the wildl Sanctuary. This Purposal must be Submitted to Ministry of Environment Forest Of Clim-Change With in Three Month from the date of pronouncement of this judgment.

We declined to prevent flying of Helicopters in the area. However, we Direct the st. Government to issue Specific direction in consonance with the aviation policy w Specific refrence to the Eco Sensitive Zones of Kedarnath Wildlife Sanctuary in 1 relation to height and level of noise that the helicopter being used by the Company shot be permitted to generated. We direct the Uttarakhand Environment protection and Poluti Control Board to give there Input to the state Government with in to Weeks of Passing this order.

3. Issuance of such of notification and other requisite steps as may be directed by the Cent Government, the State Government shall Issue measures and steps which should be tak

by the Company based on the precautionary principle.
