Office Order

In compliance to the judgment of Hon'ble High Court of Uttarakhand dated 22.08.2003 in the matter of Writ Petition No. 1719 (S/S) of 2001, the following 14 Casual Daily Labourers (CDLs) are hereby granted temporary status w.e.f. 01.09.2003 on the pattern of Department of Personnel and Training (DoPT), Government of India OM No. 51016/2/90-Estt. (C) dated 10.09.1993. The temporary status is granted in the category of Group D posts having the pay scale of Rs. 2550-55-2660-60-3200 as amended from time to time under the "Casual Labourers Grant of Temporary Status and Regularization" scheme of Government of India:

The terms and conditions of grant of Temporary Status to Group D posts are as under:

(i) They will get wages at daily rates with reference to the minimum of the pay scale for a corresponding regular Group 'D' official including DA, HRA and CCA. (Special compensatory Allowance or Compensatory (city) Allowance or Composite Hill Compensatory Allowance, etc. i.e. only one of the compensatory allowance, more beneficial to them, can be taken into account for the purpose of calculating their wages in accordance with O.M. No. 3(2)95-E.II (B), dated the 15th January, 1996. Medical facility will be allowed as per WII rules.

(ii) They will get benefits of increments at the same rate as applicable to a Group 'D' employee subject to performance of duty for at least 206 days in a year from the date of conferment of temporary status.

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(iii) They will be entitled leave on a pro rata basis at the rate of one day for every 10 days of work. Casual or any other kind of leave will not be admissible. They will also be allowed to carry forward their leave at their credit on their regularization. However, they will not be entitled to the benefits of encashment of leave on termination of service for any reason or on their quitting service.

(iv) **Regularization Scheme against Group 'D' Posts:** Regularization would be made on the principle that two out of every three vacancies in Group 'D' cadres in Wildlife Institute of India where the casual labourers have been working would be filled up as per extant recruitment rules from amongst casual workers with temporary status. However, regular Group 'D' staff rendered surplus for any reason will have prior claim for absorption against existing/future vacancies. In case of illiterate casual labourers or those who fail to fulfill the minimum qualification prescribed for post, regularization will be considered only against those posts in respect of which literacy or lack of minimum qualification will not be a requisite qualification. They would be allowed age relaxation equivalent to the period for which they have worked continuously as casual labourer. The 50% of their services rendered under temporary status would be counted for the purpose of retirement benefits after their regularization. **On regularization of casual worker with temporary status, no substitute in his place will be appointed as he was not holding any post.**

(v) After rendering three years continuous service after conferment of temporary status, the casual labourers would be treated on par with temporary Group 'D' employees for the purpose of contribution to the General Provident Fund, and would also further be eligible for the grant of Festival Advance, Flood Advance on the same conditions as are applicable to temporary Group 'D' employees, provided they furnish two sureties from Permanent Government servants of Wildlife Institute of India, Dehradun.

(vi) Until they are regularized, they would be entitled to productivity Linked Bonus/Ad hoc Bonus only at the rates applicable to Casual Labourers.

(vii) No benefits other than those specified above will be admissible to them.

(viii) Their services may be dispensed with by giving a one month's notice in writing. Similarly, they can also quit service by giving a written notice of one month. The wages for the notice period will be payable only for the days on which they are engaged on work.
