Sir,

Reference is invited to the subject mentioned above, in continuation of the above letter. The team constituted to ascertain the impact of upgradation of the said road vis-à-vis tiger dispersal and suggests measures, if deemed required, against the recommendation made by the tiger cell WII, Dehradun visited the site of the proposed road on 26.06.2016


The representative of WII, Dehradun has forwarded the report to the members of the team vide email dated 03.08.2016 with a copy to NTCA and others. In conclusion of this report, it has been stated that "there seems to be little justification to widen road width. The repairs of existing road along with the wildlife mitigation measures such as speed breakers at a distance of 300 mt., 10 under passes and 3 rumble-strips are recommended. These recommendations are suggested to mitigate the effect of vehicular speed and possible increased traffic load due the repaired road.

This is to inform you that our representative Mr. O.P. Yadav has not concurred with the recommendation of WII, Dehradun representative and submitted his observation to the NTCA vide letter referred above which is enclosed herewith for ready reference.

In view of the above, we would request to reconsider the proposal of widening and up-gradation and the said road along with the mitigation measures proposed by the WII, Dehradun. It may be pertinent to note that widening of NH-7 in similarly place/situation has been permitted along with mitigation measures by the MoEF&CC in Kanha-Pench Corridor. Therefore, the said road may be permitted for widening and up-gradation along with mitigation measures proposed by the WII, Dehradun.
