Findings VILLERIE

- All incidences except for few genuine deaths No links to supernatural or superstitious beliefs
- Incidents are independent in nature
- · Evidences were of domestic dogs/free ranging dogs in all areas
- Dogs were highly active during dark hours
- Indirect evidences were corroborated by camera traps
- One place (Bisnupur) Chinese Ferret badger, Basikhong (Leopard Cat/Feral cat) were responsible- wild animals
- There was no evidence of any major damage to humans or large livestock
