



Sub: Payment and Release of Grants-in-Aid to the Wildlife Institute of India for the year 2011-12 of Rs. 7,60,000/- for the research project titled "Assessment of dugong distribution, habitat and risks due to fisheries and other anthropogenic related activities in India" submitted by Wildlife Institute of India- reg.

Sanction of the President of India is hereby conveyed to the release of Rs. 7,60,000/- (Rupees Seven Lakh Sixty Thousand Only) towards Grant-in-Aid Wildlife Institute of India, for research project on "Assessment of dugong distribution, habitat and risks due to fisheries and other anthropogenic related activities in India" for the financial year 2011-12 (Plan).

2. The Grants-in-Aid will be regulated in accordance with the provisions contained in the agreement signed (Bond). The Grants-in-Aid is also subject to the chapter 9 of the General Financial Rules, 2005, as amended from time to time, read with the Government of India's decisions incorporated there- under, and any other guidelines which may be issued in this regard.

Further, it is stated that all requisite document/ conditions have been fulfilled particularly the followings:

(i) All relevant information and documents/ certificates as required under GFR 209(1) have been received.

The pattern of assistance of rules governing such grants-in-aid has received the approval of the Ministry of Finance, as required under Govt. of India Decision No. (1) Under DFPR- Rules 20.

(iii) dissets acquired wholly or substantially out of Government Grants shall not be disposed off without obtaining the prior approval of the sanctioning authority of Grants-in aid.

wildlife Institute of India agrees to make reservation for Scheduled Castes and Schedules Tribes or OBC the posts or services under its control on the lines indicated by Govt. of India.

The accounts of Wildlife Institute of India shall be audited by C& AG or by any person authorized by him on his behalf in accordance with the provisions laid down in Section 14 of the C&AG (DPC 1971 as amended from time to time.

The accounts of Wildlife Institute of India shall be open for inspection by the sanctioning authority and addit, both by the Comptroller & Auditor General of India under the provision of C&AG (DPC) Act, 1971 and internal audit party by the Principal Accounts Office of the Ministry or Department whenever it is called upon to do so.

(vii) Utilization Certificates have been received for Rs. Nil out of Rs. Nil released to Wildlife Institute of India up to Nil 2012 and Wildlife Institute of India shall furnish certificate alongwith its request for release of Grants-in-Aid certifying that the fund released to them has been utilized exclusively in pursuance of object envisaged in the Rules/Memorandum of Wildlife Institute of India and that the grant has been spent with the extent instruction/rules and with the approval of competent authority in each case.

(viii) Performance-cum-achievement report of Wildlife Institute of India has been received within prescribed time limit.

(ix) Noted at Serial No. 21 in the Register of Grants.

(x) Wildlife Institute of India will spend Grants-in-Aid exclusively in pursuance of the objectives envisaged in rules/memorandum of Wildlife Institute of India and for the purpose it is being sanctioned.

(xi) Grants-in-Aid to which the institute of finds is subject to the Economy made and some time by the M/O Finance or by the Competent Authority.

Utilization Certificate received of total Grant-in-Aid approved for the Wildlife Institute of India as
