Dear Sir,

It took nearly 9 months to get a response from your office after spending Rs. 78/- in the process (for two speed post), leaving aside the cost of other labour. Further, I was asked to make a payment of Rs. 18/- (3 pages x Rs. 6/-) towards photo coping charges, seems to me to be not very fair and justified. Information provided are not at all satisfactory to me. My comments are :-

SL No. 3 & 4 :

Late Dr. A. K. Roychowdhury (ex senior Scientist, Bose Research Institute, Kolkata) was the pioneer in the making of the first Tiger stud book. Thereafter, CZA brought out the second stud book compiled by Sri Bipul Chakraborty (Ex Scientist, CZA and now Director, TATA Steel Zoo) Dr. N. Bhaskar (of Arignar Anna Zoo, Chennai), Mr. S. C. Sharma (Former Member Secy., CZA) with a forward by Sri S. C. Dey, ADG, Wildlife (MEOF).

SI No. 5, 7, 9 & 10 :

It appears that instead of incorporating the necessary changes forthwith, WII would, rather, be content to carry out with the incorrect datas.

SI No. 6, 8, 11, 12 & 19 :

What action, may I know, if any, WII has taken to make the authenticated records available from the respective holding Zoos.

SI No. 18 :

Raja was **White**. Rani, partnered Raja, coming to Delhi gave birth to 20 offsprings, all **White**. One of them was Dilip (Rani & Raja's 3rd litter) . Rani's 2nd & last partner was Dilip given birth to female **White** Jayanti (D.O.B. 14/07/1973, Died on 23/07/1973). Had Rani not been **White** (as per datas entered in Int. Stud Book), all her 21 issues would not have been **White**. A **White** mating with a **White** will only breed **White** in

conformity with the principles of genetics and therefore, irrespective of the entries in the ISB Rani was **White**. Please confirm.

Sl No. 20 :

Your S.B. shows Shiva was born on 07/06/1959 sired by Raja (Barely 8 months old, D.O.B. 30/10/1958). Would you kindly confirm this in the affirmative.

Your SB Sl. Nos. 1 to 6 (Page 201)

Finally, Sire & Dan appears to be the same with NSBN 00001 in your SB. Is this as per available records with the respective holding Zoos or the ISB ?

All the above relates to only 1 page (No. 201) of your SB. There are several other pages.

I now look forward to receive your response as early as possible.
