Sub:- REQUEST FOR INFORMATION UNDER
RIGHT TO INFORMATION ACT, 2005 (RTI, 2005)

Sir,

1. With due respect, it is to inform that I (EX-Army No. 5743796W Havildar Krishna Singh Bappa of 6/B GR) have worked as an Ex-serviceman clerk/Secretarial Asst on contractual basis with the Wildlife Institute of India (WII) w.e.f. 01 Aug 1991 to 31 Mar 2014 (inclusive of approx 40-45 days break period). I was engaged temporarily on contract through Zila Saisonik Parishad, Dehradun vide Regn No. C-18/87. Before leaving the contractual service, an advance notice of dated 25 Feb 2014 was given by me wherein it was also requested the D/WII (Principal Employer) to consider granting me gratuity for rendering contractual service for a considerable period (copy enclosed). Subsequently, another request was also made vide my application dated 25 Aug 2014 but no tangible result has yet been yielded.

2. Since I am at quandary with respect to the reward ~~of~~ gratuity, I humbly request you goodself to kindly procure and arrange to provide me the following information under RTI Act, 2005 in the larger public interest:-

- (a) Terms and conditions for reward of gratuity to an employee/Worker
- (b) Whether I (Worked as monthly paid contractual engagee) am, in question, eligible to receive atleast minimum gratuity from WII on leaving my contractual service after a considerable period or otherwise not under existing gratuity Act or any other rules
- (c) Extract/copy of such ruling etc if not admissible
